WORKING UP. JERRY".

So between the date of the last letter from Jerry a month ago and yesterday, he was more or less laid up, a nice how do you do !!!!!.....

Malaria is damn all here, in South Africa, where all medicine is available, but up there, HELL.....

I have had dozens of times Malaria, even Black Water Fever, they said. But in comparison with the conditions of treatment, there is no patch to talk off of what this malady must be there....

That will do to-day.
