My dear Israel,

I am sending you Leivi's letter to show you what a really unatural view he takes of things.

This is truly wonderful ! I got intimation that with the twwn of "Artemovsk", late "achmut" there awaits me 10 Dollars, apparantly from Leivi, though the letter never told me anytging about it. The money from apetown (i.e. 21.10.0. and 22.0.0.) I waver have never received. Moscow has answered me on my querry (at last, after 26 days) that they know nothing about it and would I give them the number of the cheques &.....

I injubed myself a little a few hours ago, a cocopan of Never Mind ! concrete went over my toe. I thought nothing of it at first, but now I am at home enjoying a few hours rest.

Of course, this is a mere trifle I congratulate you with having become an Uncle once again. I receive all your letters and thank you very, very much

indeed. They are so sincere and open hearted, that which so lacks here!...
I receive all the news papers that you and Aaron send me.

Everyone of them. Today I am glad torgat them more and at greater detail than ever before. And this is not homesickness, but the hatred of lies and falsehoods here in the press.

For who can , and how can a man praise either the organior the labour conditions here on the "Moscow9Donbas" construction on which I work; and tell of its wonderfull tempos when this is a crying shame and terrible lie .....

There are lies in your press, many lies, but these here are

Do you feel, Israel, that my political ideals before my arrifar greater i..... val here have been terribly hit, and I feel terribly disappointed and hurt and bad I.....

dissolusionment, Eh III.....

who would have thought of it I .... One lives in a cloak of darkness here, political and otherwise! from the Pravda alone, and that unfortunately is the case for all the countless millions of Russians. I may die and know literally nothing as as to what is happening, except the tennage of coal, as if it were really true--- mined and the steel rolled and the wheat sown on the

different points of the Union. I You may get impressed with the figures, but not I, for I have also compiled these and have seen these compiled for publication and have seen the huge machine working !

What a dissilussionment this comes to me !.. And perhaps just as well ! That is all akan I have to say.
