Dear Mr Fortes,

I am sending you up several letters received from Jerry, 4 letters received this week, the latest of these is dated the 25th of January 1933, also an old one to Sister, received here at the beginning of this month. I omitted to enclose same in my last week's letters.

I further enclose a copy of a letter of mine to him, posted air mail.

These speak for themselves.

I do not know if I have enclosed a copy of my letter to Jerry last week for your perusal.

The position to-day is, that Jerry must leave the USSR without any qualifications, and must not try to renew even his Visa.

At present, he is ICE BOUND, but with the drawing nearer of Spring, he must leave the country.

That much is --- clear.

Please treat all these letters in confidence, as requested previously in my letter of last week.

It is because I realise that Jerry cannot keep up that enormous correspondence with all his ~~fix~~ friends, that I have started sending you copies of his letters to me, and others.

I His method is this in writing. He writes to me or Sister and type several copies out of his original letters and I distribute these carbon copies accordingly to every one respectively, without the loss of a single mail.

I have arranged for a box of Grapes to be sent to you, at last. I trust it will arrive in good condition.
