6/7/33

Dear (Israel),

Thanks for your letters etc.

I also received your letter about "Imme" in the third person. Thanks very much. Everything is noted.

Yes; "discretion is the better part of valour"; but at times I lost the former !.

To-day, I am alos in a bad mood.

I shall not write much.

You note; I received your letter of the 9/5/33 yesterday, i.e. in far less than a month. London papers sometimes reaches me in 8 days. "eivi's in 14-15 days.

How wonderful fast my cables arrive !!...

I rarely saw their equal. And everyword correct. Do you see how efficient Russians are in despatching foreign telegrams. Local ones, from Moscow to Kharkov may take days and often not reach ~~their~~ their destination at all !!.

I live in a neighbourhood of thieves !! No amount of locks seem to help.

My razors are gone. Those I got a present from the mountaineering crowd.

I shall soon lose something more ! I am quite used to the prospects.
