My dear Belle,

I have received the following cable from Jerry this morning, and have wired over contents to you.

It is dated : GORKI 8/8/33 at 8.45. p.m. arrived Johannesburg same date at 12.45. a.m. and at Tzaneen at 9.10. a. m. on the 9th August.

In other words, it took 4 hours for the cable to reach Johannesburg from GORKI, and 9 hours 25 minutes from Johannesburg to Tzaneen, of course the latter was overnight, and the post office does not open before 9 a.m. here.

The contents of the cable:

" INTERESTINGLY OCCUPIED CONSTRUCTION WORK .MATERIALLY  
" WELLOFF. ONLY MISSING SINCERE FRIENDS THROUGH  
" WORK. WRITING LITTLE . DONT WORRY . LOVE. JERRY. "

There are two words that I should say are not quite clear. (1) The word through (which I have above underlined appears a "TROUGH", mutilated, and it means either, I should say, "ROUGH" or "THROUGH". (2) The word ~~KITKAK~~ "LITTLE" means either "LITTLE" or "LETTER".

The following is ~~ax~~ the way the cable was delivered here:

" Interestingly occupied construction work materially welloff only missing sincere friends trough work writing little dont worry love. JERRY "

As I am sending Jerry a copy of this letter, it will serve as an acknowledgement of this cable.
